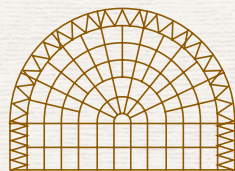

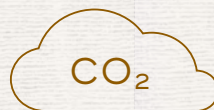

AN ICON REIMAGINED.

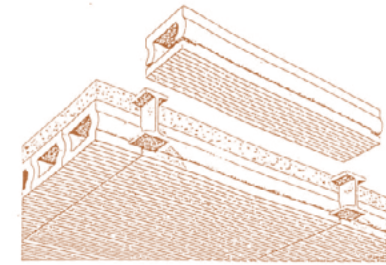
The Gilbert, a vibrant space blending the charm of the past with the possibility of the future.

The Gilbert, once a members only club designed by Architects Frederick Gould and Giles Gilbert Scott, has been reimaged to cater to the

needs of the modern worker and workspace. The extensive refurbishment saw minimal demolition which allowed the heritage building to retain 90% of the embodied carbon and retain its charm and place in history.

NET ZERO IN CONSTRUCTION

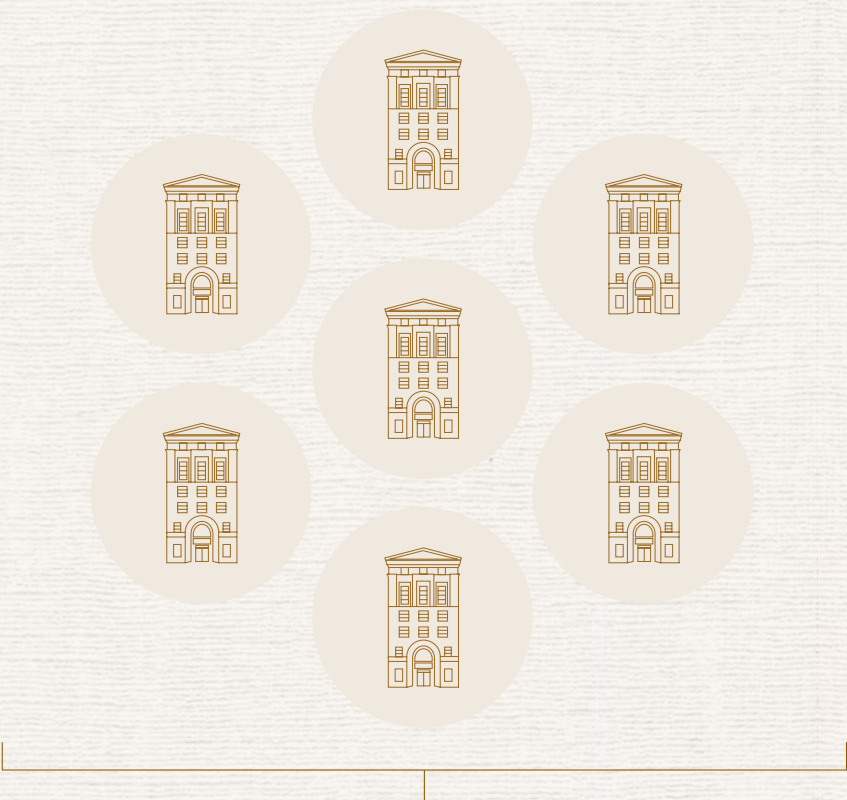
The Gilbert, the first Net Zero in Construction project by BGRE, exemplifies a commitment to sustainable development.

Compared to a new build, The Gilbert’s refurbishment saved approximately 80% of embodied carbon emissions and achieves comparable energy efficiency. Choosing office space here translates to an immediate reduction of around 9,000 kgCO²e per workplace – the equivalent of not using a car for 4.5 years, avoiding 29 London-to-New York flights, or planting 450 trees!

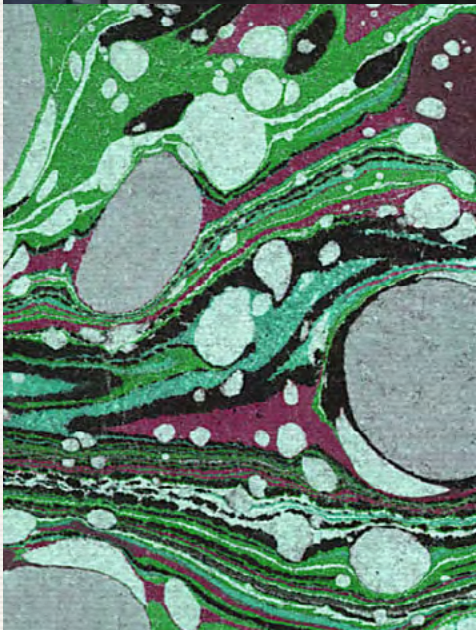

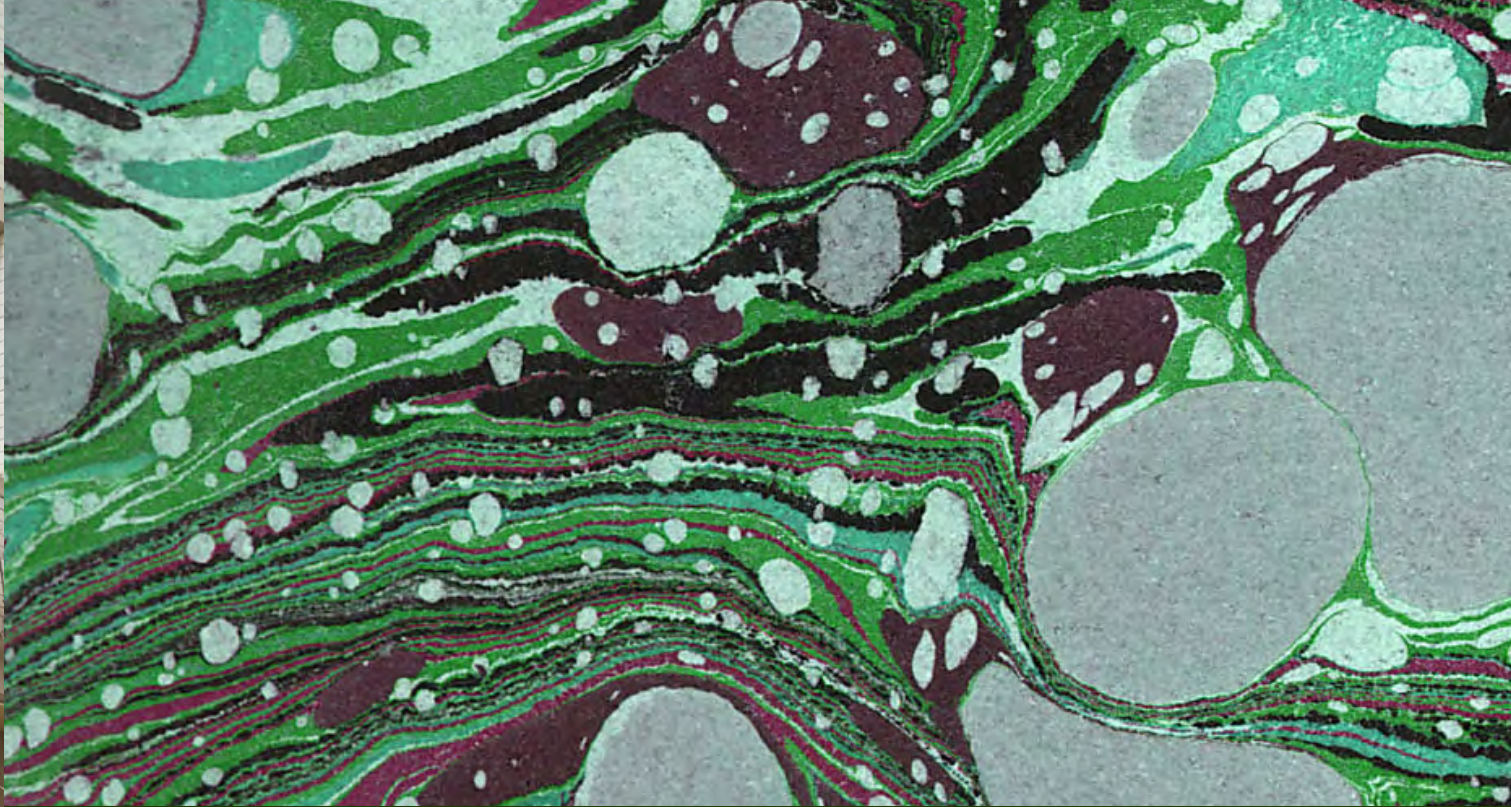
